



The ruling represents the second time in one year that the Court has found that the Government of Canada has failed to comply with its obligations to produce documents to the TRC. In January 2013, Justice Stephen Goudge ordered the government to produce documents housed in Library and Archives Canada to the TRC which had been previously withheld.
