

Canada to work with the Government of Ontario to develop an approach to resource development that recognizes and respects the rights and interests of First Nations. This would include substantive discussions on the recognition of First Nation jurisdiction over their lands, including resource revenue sharing and opportunities for NAN communities through education and training, employment and business development.

Nishnawbe Aski Nation is a political territorial organization representing 49 First Nation communities in James Bay Treaty No. 9 and Ontario portions of Treaty No. 5 – an area covering two thirds of the province of Ontario in Canada.
